Tag Question

Basic:

I am right, ain't I? / aren't I?

We have to hurry, don't we?

The work can be done, can't it?

Advanced:

* Negative words (neither, no, none, no one, no body, nothing, scarcely, hardly, barely, seldom, hardly ever, anyone, anybody, little, few etc.) Sentence এর মাঝে থাকলে Tag Question, Positive হয়

It's hardly rained all this summer, has it?

There is nothing we can do about it, is there?

* Ambiguous verb (He's, he'd)

He's working now, isn't he?

He's gone there, hasn't he?

Tag Question

Advanced:

* Complex Sentence এর Principal Clause এর subject এবং verb অনুযায়ী
Tag Question বসে

It is said that Akbar was a great king, isn't it?

He told that you were not here, didn't he?

* Pronoun এর Subjective form

It, Something, anything, everything, nothing ----- it

No one, nobody, none, neither ----- they

everyone, everybody, someone, somebody ----- they

here, there ----- unchanged

* Imperative Sentence

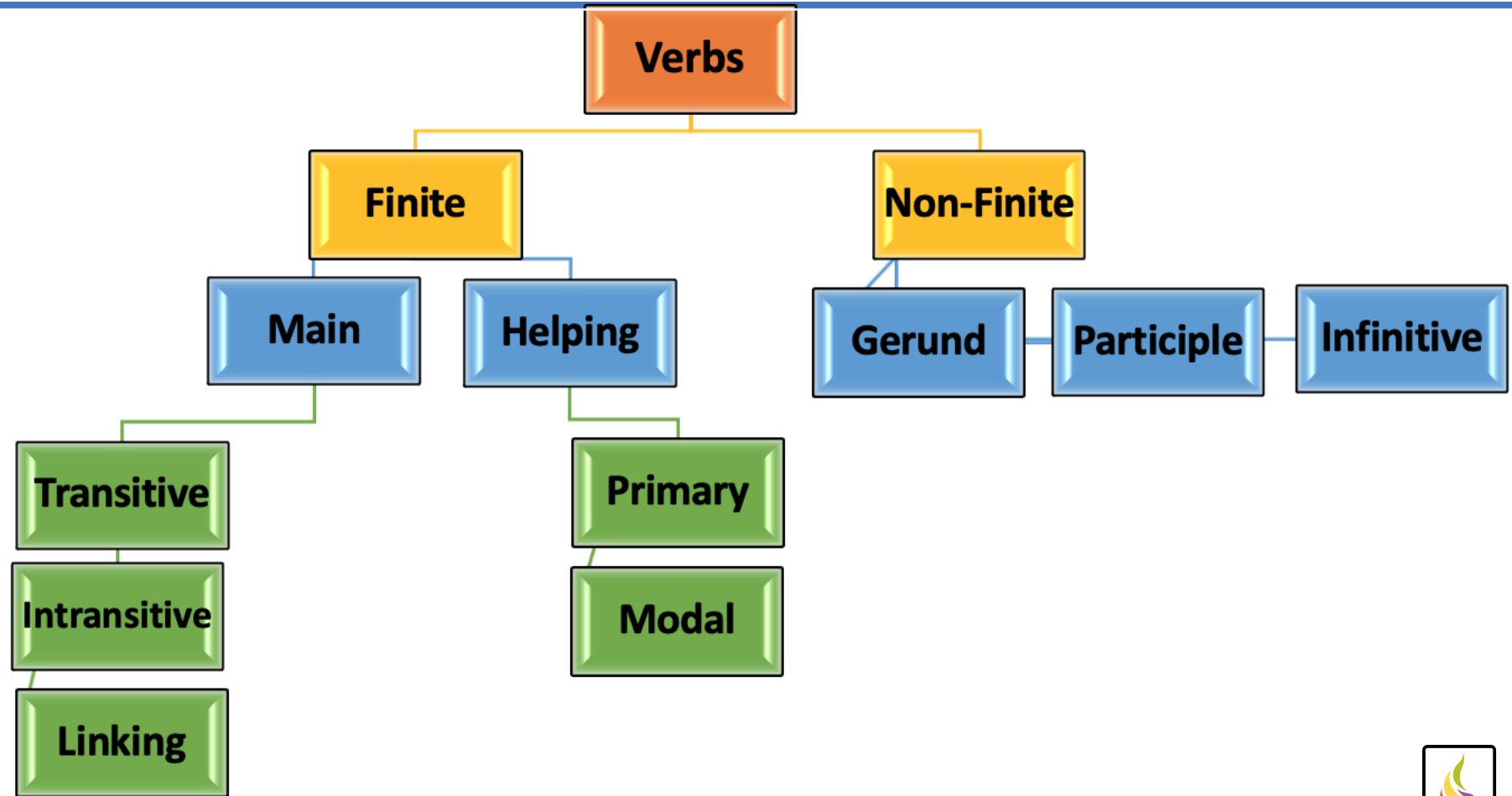
(Positive, Negative, Let's)

Important Rules:

- **After/ Before**
They arrived the station after the train (leave)
- **No sooner had – than, Scarcely had – when**
No sooner had the bell rung than the teacher (enter) the classroom
- **Since**
It was many years since I (visit) there
- **It is time, It is high time**
It is time you (finish) the homework
- **I wish, I fancy**
I wish I (be) a rich man
- **As if, as though**
He behaves as if he (buy) the car
- **While**
While it (rain), I was going to college

Right Forms of Verb

Conditionals:

- * If conditionals

Subject Verb Agreement:

- * Either... or, neither... nor
- * along with, together with, accompanied by, in addition to etc.
- * Time, distance, money

Sentence Correction

1. Redundancy Errors

Incorrect: I have sufficient enough money

Correct: I have enough money

2. Parallelism Errors

Incorrect: She cooked food and cleaning the house

Correct: She cooked food and cleaned the house

3. Modifier Errors

Incorrect: He nearly failed all the subjects he took

Correct: He failed nearly all the subjects he took

Same word but different parts of speech

Wrong seldom prospers
